A Note from the Principal

Dear Families

WELCOME BACK from spring break! I hope you all had some extra time to spend with your child, were able to enjoy the nice weather, and had time to read to or with your child. We have almost 8 weeks of school left and so much to accomplish. Just a few reminders for the last quarter of school:

- ❖ All students need to be dressed in the school uniform:
Solid colored polo shirts (no words, emblems, or logos)
Blue, black or khaki cotton twill pants,
All boys must wear a belt
Shoes must have a back to them to stay on the feet (no flip flops)
- ❖ All students are responsible for reading ,or being read to, each week, completing a reading log and turning it in on Tuesday morning. K-2 students should read, or be read to, 60 minutes a week; 3-5 students should read, or be read to, 90 minutes a week.
- ❖ Students should not be dropped off before 8:05 in the morning or picked up before 3:00 (unless they have a doctors appointment). If they arrive to school after 8:25 an adult must come in to the office to sign them in to school. If your child is absent from school you must call the school before 9:00.

Thank you for making sure your child is here on time, dressed appropriately and reading.
