CICO

- Check In Check Out (CICO) is a targeted, Secondary (or Tier 2) intervention that provides some students a higher frequency of scheduled, positive feedback from adults, as well as progress monitoring through the use of a daily point sheet. Throughout the day, students on CICO are given positive, constructive feedback on their behavior based on the schoolwide expectations: Respect Yourself, Respect Others, and Respect Property. Students may be referred to CICO by school staff, the problem solving team, parents, or themselves. If a parent wishes to refer a student to CICO, he/she should contact the student's teacher.
