

SPECIAL INSTRUCTION FOR SUMMER PROGRAM

ELIGIBILITY: Student registration requests must be signed by the home high school administrator or counselor. *Representatives from each high school will be on hand to assist with registration on June 1st from 7:30a.m. – 5:30p.m at Southeast High school.*

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

Drivers Education & Cons. Ed. – Two (2) days of absences allowed.

Communication/Speech, Algebra 134a, & PE - Three (3) days of absences allowed.

All other courses – Students must complete coursework at Summer School. Students will work at their own pace. Once students complete a course, they do not need to continue to attend. Three (3) days of absences are allowed.

***Tardiness counts against these days, two (2) tardies = 1/2 day absence.**

***Students will be dropped from a course if absences exceed allowed days. There will be no refund if drop date is after June 22nd.**

GUIDELINES FOR ENROLLING IN DRIVERS ED

(Out of District Students) Students who reside outside the boundaries of District 186, and who are not enrolled in a local private or parochial school must submit a written request. That request must include a statement of prior agreement by the home school district to reimburse District 186 for instructional costs in excess of the \$250.00 fee to the District 186 Coordinator of Drivers Education, 530 West Reynolds Street, Springfield, IL 62704.
