The Lincoln Library is providing a FREE eCard to *all* K-12 students who live within District 186 boundaries. This card gives students access to a wealth of online books, magazines, newspapers, research materials, etc. Students will be able to access these materials on any device at school and home. Since the materials are all digital, there will be no late fees.

Once students have received an eCard library number, they will follow the directions below to access materials:

- Go to <http://www.lincolnlibrary.info/>
- Select “My Account and sign in
- Select “eDownloads” or eResources” in the left-hand column
 - eResources are the databases and online reference books available for use
 - eDownloads are any resource that provides downloadable material
