Dear Parent or Guardian,

Please be advised that the required college and career readiness assessment for the state of Illinois is the SAT. The School Day SAT will be administered this year on Tuesday, April 9, 2019. School Day SAT scores are included in a student's permanent record. Some students also choose to take the ACT, an additional college and career readiness assessment.

In August of 2017, the Illinois General Assembly approved a new law, which removes the requirement that college and career readiness assessment scores be included on a student's transcript. We are writing to inform you of this new law and let you know of your right as a parent to determine whether or not you would like your child's scores to be included on his or her transcript. Please complete the form below to provide your approval for your child's SAT and/or ACT scores to be included on their high school transcript.

Please also be advised that the college or university to which your child is applying and/or is admitted to may request official score reports. Students may also qualify to have scores sent to colleges or universities in addition to those sent during the regular administration of the SAT.
