**Technology Use**

**Technology use is a privilege. Students are responsible for the care and safety of any laptop or electronic device assigned to them. Always respect yourself, others, and property. Conferences may lead to the development of an individual technology plan and/or intervention.**

**Activities that may result in a Classroom Teacher Conference and loss of privileges include, but are not limited to:**

1. Accessing personal e-mail accounts from school computers is prohibited.
2. Accessing System Preferences, including changing desktop pictures and the network access point.
3. Accessing non-approved programs and sites.
4. Loading and downloading software.
5. Releasing personal information.
6. Not adhering to copyright laws or plagiarising work from another source or student.
7. Vandalism or tampering with any component of technology.
8. Accessing and/or altering work, other than your own.
9. Using student webpages and Google Docs for non-educational purposes.
10. Students are responsible for the care and safety of any electronic device assigned to them.

**Activities that might lead to an Administrative Conference are not limited to the items above. Violations relating to *physically damaging technology, accessing social networking sites, pornography/sexually explicit material, cyberbullying, gambling or illegal acts* will be referred to administration through a discipline office referral, and processed accordingly.**
