(Add your favorite nerdy accessories to your uniform.)



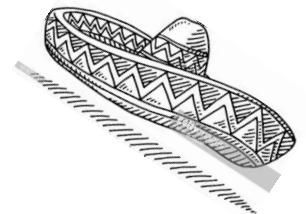
**Tuesday, October 27th: Sock Day**
