The requirements for Promotion are as follows:

- Promotion at the middle school level is based on semester grades. A passing grade in middle school is a D or better.
- Semester grades are a cumulative average of first and second quarter grades as well as third and fourth quarter grades.
- District 186's current Board of Education Promotion Policy states that students must pass all core subjects.

If your student fulfills these requirements, you will receive a personal invitation in the mail for the ceremony. We want to make sure our families and students are informed of these requirements.
