

[EDpuzzle](#) in the Classroom

As the use of video becomes more prominent in teaching, it is important that students have experience with learning how to gather and synthesize the information from this type of text. EDpuzzle is a website that allows teachers to upload videos and add interactive features that include audio track, audio comments, open ended or multiple choice questions, and text comments.

EDpuzzle has a gallery that includes a wide variety of videos, however, due to our network, most of these video sites are blocked. Teachers will need to convert the video, upload it to Edpuzzle, and add their own interactive features. Teachers can convert and download video files (YouTube videos) with a tool such as [Filewiggler](#). [Directions for converting video files](#) can be found on the District Instructional Technology website.

An iPad app is available for EDpuzzle, however, it is only for students to access videos, not for the creation of videos.

A sample EDpuzzle class has been created for viewing example videos. To access this class, sign in as a student and use the following class code: **epYLMm**. For our purpose of this EDpuzzle example, the user is allowed to skip through the video. Teachers do have the capability to require students to complete embedded questions/prompts in their EDpuzzles before moving on.
