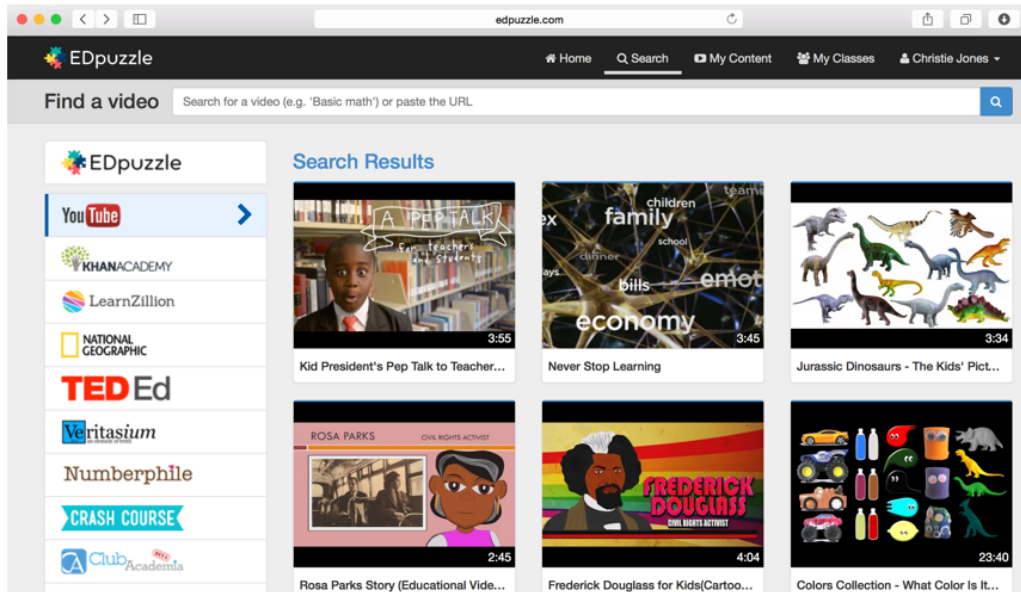


## You Spoke, EDpuzzle Listened!

EDpuzzle, as you read in some of our previous Tech Tidbits, is a great resource to create interactive videos for your students. However, one drawback in using EDpuzzle has been the inability to use many of the videos found in the EDpuzzle video gallery because they are housed in Youtube. Many teachers spoke out and EDpuzzle listened, and they have now changed EDpuzzle so that even if you are in a district that blocks Youtube (which we have to do because of bandwidth issues), you can now use all of the videos in their gallery. You don't have to do anything other than search the gallery, select a video, and make it an interactive learning tool for your students.

First, go to SEARCH and select a video.



Once selected, click on USE THIS VIDEO (if you are ready to work on the video now) or SAVE TO MY CONTENT (which saves it for you to work on later). Then, use the editing tools we mentioned in previous Tech Tidbits to create your interactive video.
