As we end this school year, we want to share one last Tech Tidbit. A question we often get is, “Are there resources that I can use to create tech-enhanced items similar to the questions students encounter on PARCC assessments?” [Edulastic](#) appears to be an answer to that question.

Edulastic is a site aligned to Illinois Learning Standards (CCSS). It allows teachers to create assessments for their classes using a variety of question types such as: drag and drop, label an image, classification, multiple selection, text dropdown, resequencing, expression evaluator, numeric entry with units, number line, range plotter, and graph placement. Teachers can create their own questions or choose from a bank of standards-aligned questions. These assessments are easy to assign, track, and grade. In addition, real-time data can be used to understand the strengths and weaknesses of students. We encourage you to look at this versatile resource over the summer.
