# Career Discovery Summer Camp

## Basic Car Care

Participants will learn how to:

- Work safely
- Change and rotate tires
- Check and adjust tire pressure
- Change oil and filter
- Check belts, hoses, and fluids
- Perform a vehicle inspection
- Clean a vehicle
- Use various tools and equipment in the shop



## Auto Body/Collision Repair

Participants will learn to:



- Work safely
- Follow refinishing and paint application processes to repaint a small student project.
- Use hand tools, power tools, and automotive painting materials to refinish a student project (materials provided)

### Student project:

Students will be given a brand new metal mail box. They will have to come up with a custom design and color scheme to be applied to the mail box. They will then receive their custom mail box to take home.

## Photography

Participants will learn to:

- Transition from film photography to digital photography
  - Photograph landscapes, architecture, and people
  - Transfer images and enhance them with Adobe Photoshop software
- Student may bring their own digital cameras and learn how to use them.

Students will have digital prints or an album to keep at the end of the camp.

- All camp activities will be conducted and supervised by a certified CACC Instructor
- Each camper will receive a t-shirt
- Cost is only \$60 for the entire session
- Campers must have completed 7th, 8th, or 9th grade
