Respect Self:

Be in assigned seat before the bell.
Be prepared for class. Bring all needed materials to class everyday.
Use class time efficiently.
Be dressed appropriately.

Respect Others:

Students will show respect toward the teacher, substitute teaches, guest and other teachers at all times.
Keep hands, feet, and objects to self.
Use an appropriate voice. Raise hand for questions, comments or permission to leave classroom or move about the room.
Do not use electronics devices in the classroom.
Must use computer to work ONLY on class assignment.

Respect Property:

Be considerate of school property and others' property.
Coats, backpacks, large purses, and bags are not allowed in the classroom.
Be neat- put garbage in garbage cans, return books and other items to their proper places: take your belongings with you.
Food and drinks are not allowed in the classroom unless otherwise instructed.
Be careful with school-owned and teacher owned property- repair or clean damaged property; leave desks in their current position and ask to move; respect property in library.

Rewards:

Verbal praise
Positive parent contacts (emails, phone calls, note cards)
Treat days

General Consequences:

<i>*First consequence--</i>	Verbal Warning
<i>*Second consequence--</i>	Student conference with teacher(focus on appropriate Behavior to avoid future issues)
<i>*Third consequence--</i>	15 minute detention and contact parent
<i>*Fourth consequence--</i>	Referral to assistant principal/intern (May lose computer privileges.) Parent contact
<i>*Severe clause--</i>	If the disruptive behavior is severe enough the first three steps are disregarded and the student is automatically referred to the assistant principal/intern.
<i>*Restorative step--</i>	If student behavior results in removal from class, a brief student/ teacher conference will be conducted upon student returning to class in order to move forward on a positive and productive note.

ANY student behavior that a substitute teacher feels warrants a written note of said behavior to me, will result in an immediate referral to the office upon my return.

***THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.** You MUST stand and be respectful during the recitation of The Pledge of Allegiance. Many men and women have given their lives to afford you this privilege. Disrespect during this time, WILL NOT be tolerated.

***BE in YOUR SEAT when the BELL RINGS; otherwise, you will be marked Tardy! See student handbook for Tardy Policy.**

***FOOD AND DRINK .** You may bring water nothing else. If you bring in a water bottle, you are expected to take it with you when you go. **NO FOOD OR DRINK BY THE COMPUTERS!!**

***Please note that you are allowed to chew gum in my class provided that you follow the following rules:**

I don't want to hear it.

I don't want to see it.

I don't want to find it stuck anywhere in this classroom.

Gum is NOT to be in your mouth when you give a speech.

When you throw away your gum, please wrap it in tissue or paper.

***ASSIGNED SEATING.** You will be given an assigned seat. It is expected that you sit in that seat everyday. If you are not in your assigned seat, the classroom has a substitute teacher, and that teacher writes your name down for a discipline issue, but you claim that "it wasn't me because so and so was in my seat" you will still receive disciplinary action.
