

## 2nd Quarter Learning Standards for Art

### 1st Grade:

- ☉ Match the color name to red, yellow, blue, green, orange, and violet.
- ☉ Differentiate a drawing from examples of other genres.
- ☉ Tell about a school-related experience in the arts.
- ☉ Recognize portraits.

### 2nd Grade:

- ☉ Identify primary colors.
- ☉ Identify secondary colors.
- ☉ Identify tertiary colors.
- ☉ Distinguish between light and dark values.
- ☉ Distinguish the difference between a drawing and a painting.
- ☉ Utilize the colors of the color wheel to create a work of art.
- ☉ Tell about an experience in the arts outside of school.

### 3rd Grade:

- ☉ Name the neutral colors.
- ☉ Name the analogous colors.
- ☉ Recognize warm, cool, and neutral color families.
- ☉ Describe moods/emotions in two or more works of art with the same subject.
- ☉ Create a composition expressing a mood or emotion from observation, research or imagination.
- ☉ Construct a color wheel in a given media.
- ☉ Describe ways the arts can be used for personal enrichment.
- ☉ Classify works of art into groups (narrative, portrait, landscape, and still-life).
- ☉ Differentiate a still life from examples of other genres.

### 4th Grade:

- ☉ Discern that values can be applied to color using tints and shades.
- ☉ Compare mood/emotion in several portraits.
- ☉ Select a specific art material to communicate a given idea.
- ☉ Distinguish the differences among painting, drawing, sculpture, weaving, and printmaking.
- ☉ Create a portrait.
- ☉ List where the four fine arts are observed in commercial applications and everyday life.
- ☉ Categorize expressive works of art.
- ☉ Categorize a landscape, cityscape, and seascape.

## 5th Grade:

- Explain the use of a light source in creating light and shadow.
- Distinguish between figure and ground in a still life.
- Distinguish the differences between painting, drawing, sculpture, weaving, printmaking, and photography.
- Create a still life.
- Demonstrate the effects of light on forms in a work of art.
- Define ways dance, drama, music and visual art play a role in everyday life.
- Categorize non-representational and abstract works of art.
