

## **Current Communication Speech Day Advanced Speech-Mrs. Davis**

\*You will need to find an article from either a newspaper, magazine, or from a reputable on-line source (see me if you're not sure) once each week of class. See syllabus.

\*In choosing your article, try to find one that deals with some sort of communication issue.

\*If you cannot find an article on a communication issue, then choose an article that you feel will be interesting and educational for your audience.

\*You will be assigned to speak either every Tuesday or every Thursday.

\*In preparing your speech, you will need to do the following:

- Use the "Reliability Checklist" to determine the legitimacy of the article
- State the title of the article.
- State the title of the magazine, newspaper, or on-line source where the article came from.
- State the date of the article.
- State the author, if known.
- Effectively explain the article in a 2-3 minute speech.
- Explain why you think this article is important enough to share with your audience.
- Be sure to have an introduction, and conclusion.
- Be prepared for questions after your speech.
