We are able to understand what we read and share our own thoughts.

**Reading** ~ This week we are working on different types of reading. We are currently reading <u>Hatchet</u> by Gary Paulsen. Hatchet is the story of a boy named Brian. On a trip to the Canadian oilfields to spend the summer with his dad, the pilot of the Cessna he is traveling in suffers a heart attack and dies. Brian must land the plane in the forest. Brian learns to exist in this wilderness. We have just finished chapter 6 in this story, and so far the children seem to be enjoying it.

We are also continuing on with our reading book. This week we are reading a story called "The Fear Place". We will be discussing this story for the rest of the week.
