ALL STUDENTS WILL/MAY WEAR

Any short/long sleeved solid colored polo style shirt with a collar (No words, emblems, or logos permitted)

Any Graham school shirt (which has been purchased from Graham School)

During cold weather, students may wear a solid colored turtleneck or long sleeve t-shirt under their polo shirt, or a solid colored crew neck sweatshirt over their polo shirt (no words, emblems, or logos permitted)

Blue, black, or khaki pants (no athletic shorts/pants, leggings, denim, or knit pants)

Blue, black or khaki shorts may be worn before fall break and after spring break (no athletic shorts)

All students must tuck their shorts into their pants

All clothes must be appropriately sized

Sock should be worn with all shoes other than sandals

If boys pants have belt loops they must wear a belt with their pants

Girls may wear

Blue, black, or khaki shirts or jumpers

Capri pants or skorts before fall break and after spring break

No student may wear

Denim of any kind

Flip Flop shoes

Hoodies or zippered jackets during class time
