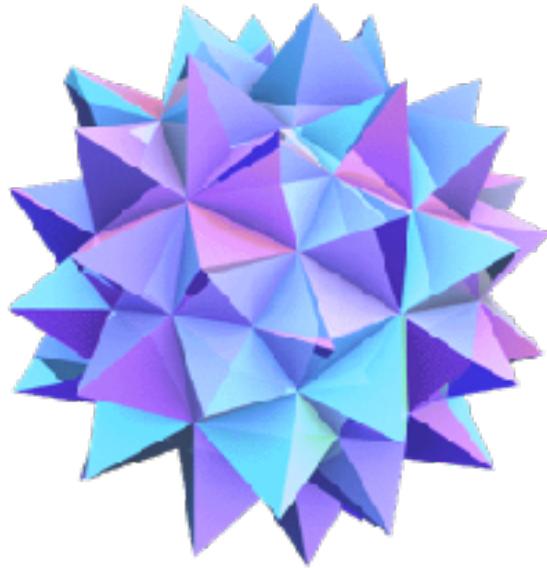

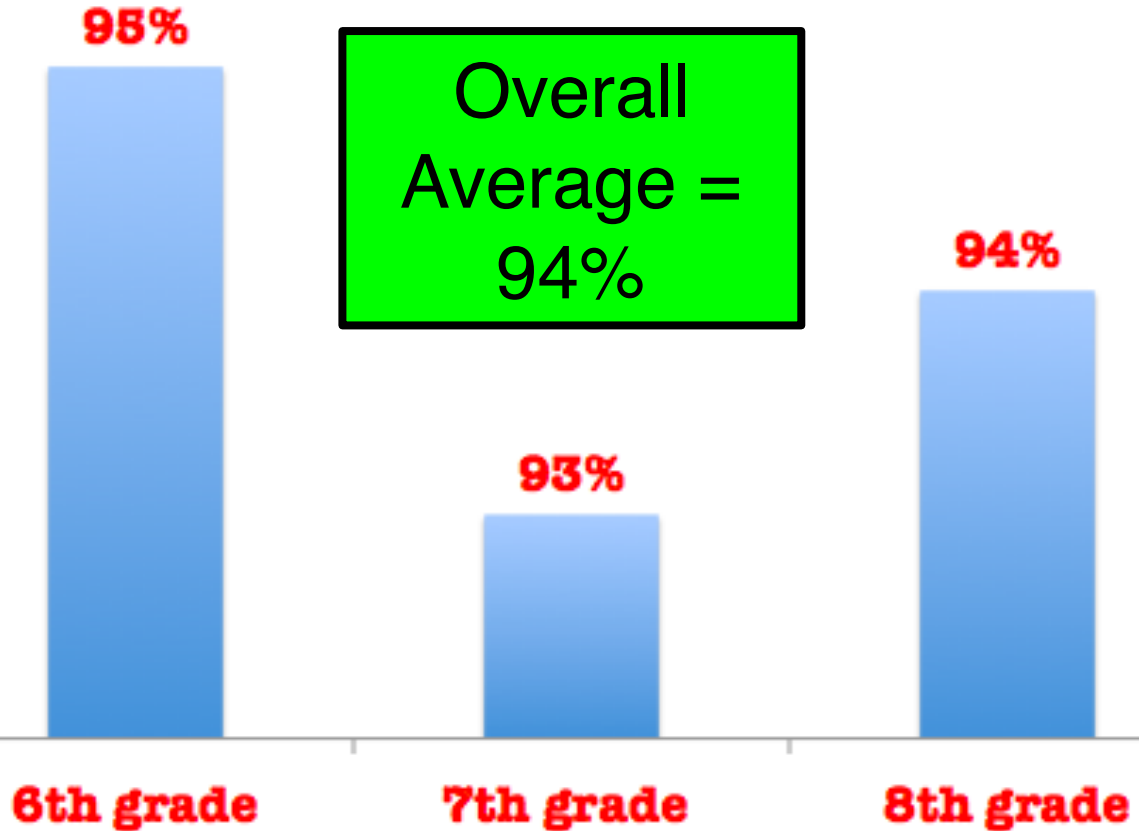

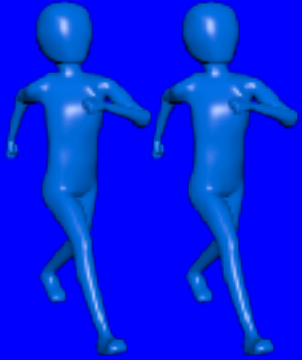

The Falcons were unable to build off of this momentum, as the Titans stretched the lead back to double digits in the fourth, winning the game 40-27. 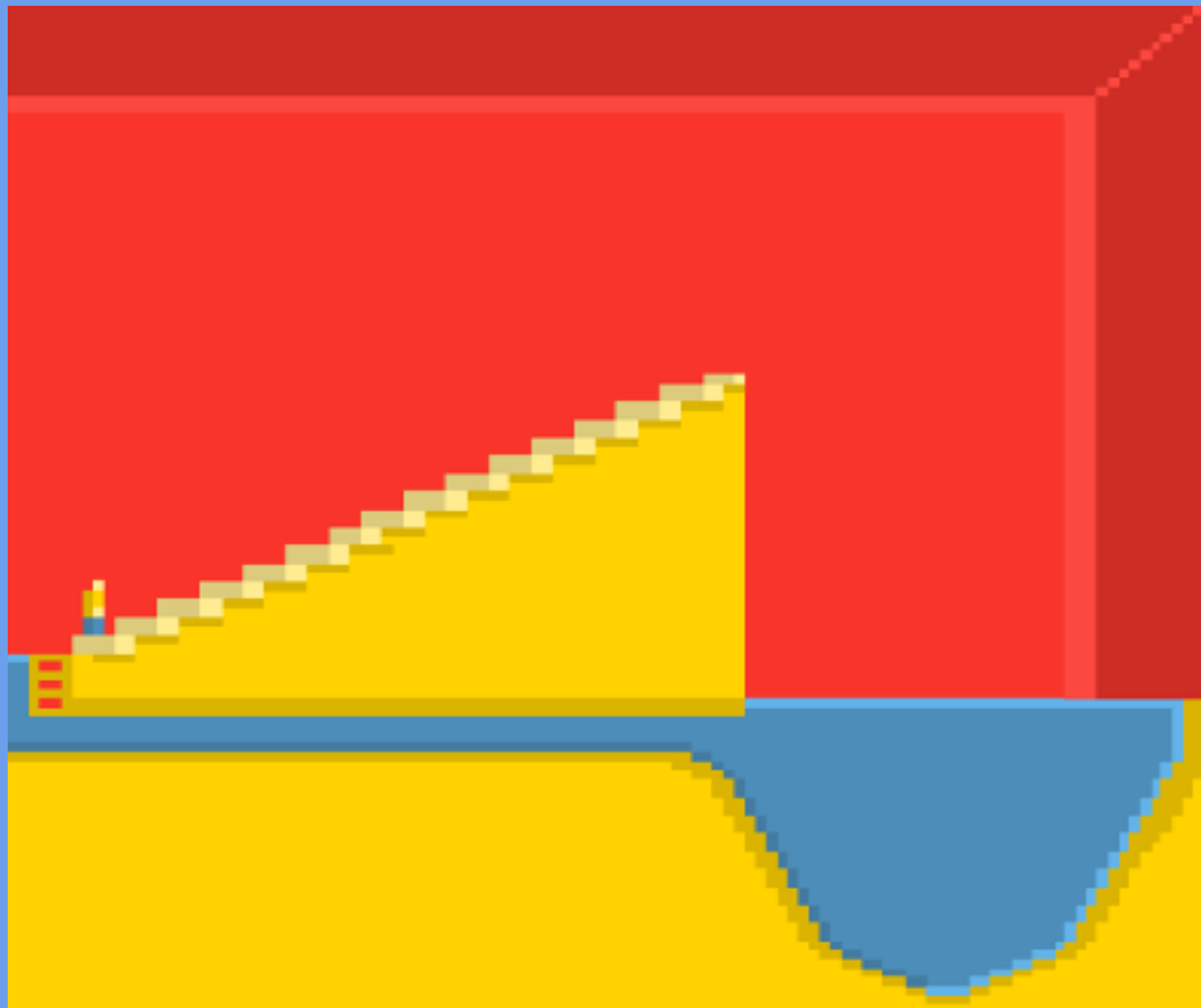

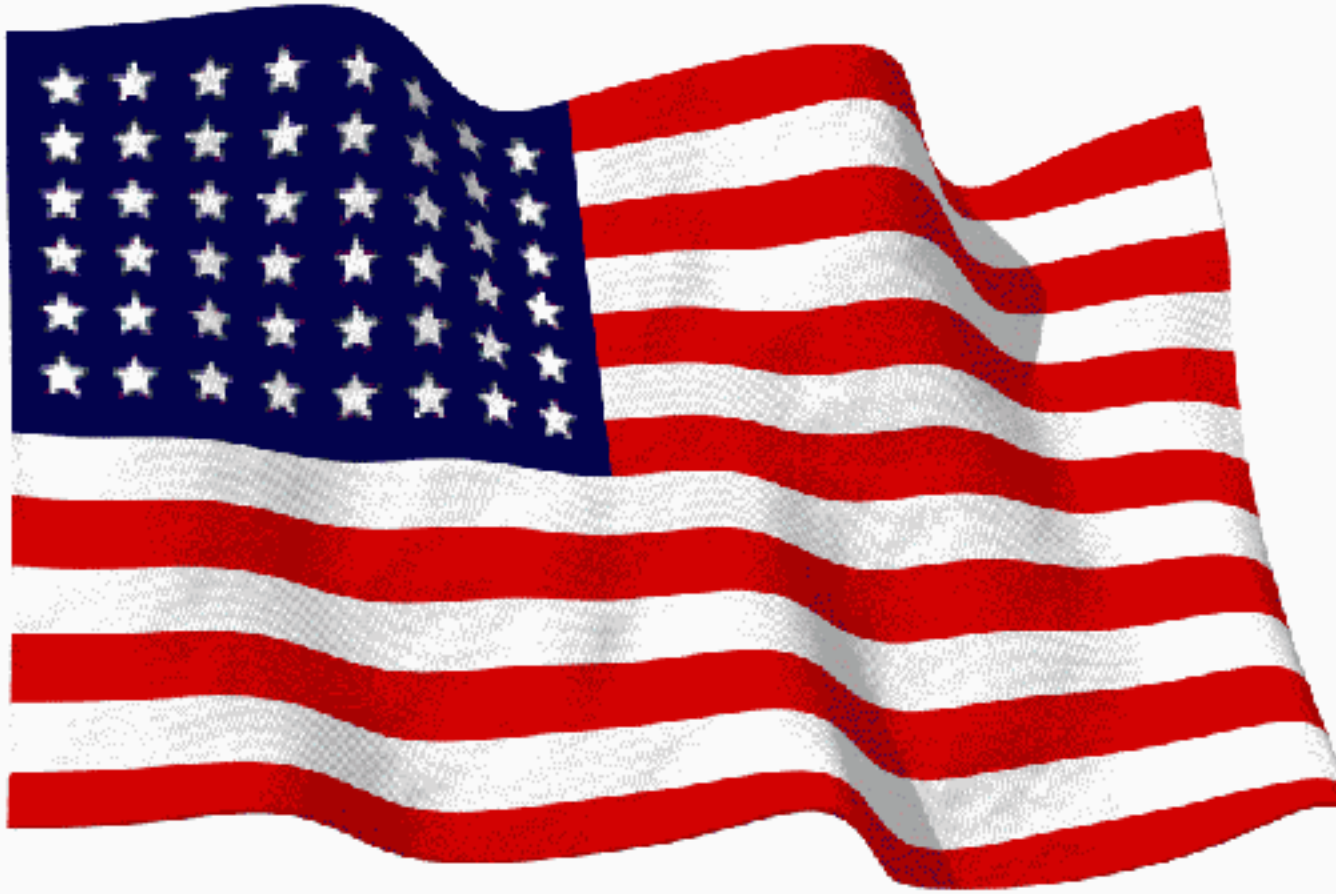
