Dear Families and Students,

Starting today, Tuesday, April 14, spring break is officially over and we will be starting formal online and home learning. I have created a lesson plan for you and your student to follow everyday for this week. I will send 2 more weeks worth of plans towards the end of the week for the following weeks, April 20-30. After this week our lessons will cover Monday-Thursday and Friday can be used as a catch up day.

The assignments do not have to be done back to back unless you have a chunk of time and want to. I know that for some families it works best to do things in the morning and some do it in the evening. Sending me things on seesaw is okay to do at all times of the day. Many of these things will need your help and/or supervision so please keep this in mind as many of you might still be working and making a schedule for your family during these new times.

The Illinois State Board of Education has told school districts what is required and our district has laid out a plan for each grade level. Kindergarten should be spending between 30-90 minutes of learning and work each day. Teachers have now been instructed to take grades and account for which students are completing work. I will be filling out a checklist to keep track of all my students and their work submitted to me. I will also keep checking in with all families to see how I can assist them and what else I can do to help you in this process. Your child needs you now more than ever to help them be successful as we finish this year and go into the next year with as little learning loss as possible especially heading into summer.

The way I will keep track of each student's progress is through Seesaw. When work gets finished from the lesson plan, pictures and videos need taken and posted on Seesaw so I can see. Students can still complete the activities that were previously in the lightbulb area of Seesaw, but they are not required to do the activities assigned before today.

We will be having a zoom meeting Monday-Thursday (with the exception of this week being Tuesday-Friday) starting Tuesday, April 14. I know that every student can not attend everyday and that is okay. Just have them sign in when possible. The meeting ID number will be the same everyday. I would put the number on a sticky note and put it on the refrigerator as well. You can teach your student to get on the app and type in the number all by themselves. I would also set a timer on their iPad to go off five minutes before the meeting is scheduled. This can be a reminder of the zoom meeting because I know life gets in the way. See the lesson plan for the Zoom schedule. **The ID number is 930 897 998 and the password is 12345.** Now passwords are required for all zoom meetings for safety concerns.

As of right now math for our class will be a little different than the other two Harvard Park Kindergarten classes. I am trying to coordinate the safest way for myself and my family to get your child their math books. Until I get that figured out we will be using a website called iKnowit and Pearson (the same website as our math book). We will still be learning the same math topic, just in a slightly different way.

I don't expect this first week to go perfectly. We will learn as we go what works and what doesn't. Please don't hesitate to call, text, or email me with any questions and assistance on any of the lesson plans.
