Attention FMS Students with District Chromebooks

If you have issues with your Chromebook, please check out this document on the FMS webpage.



This document is designed for students/ families to "self-report" problems with the District assigned laptop-

- broken screen (typically has lines going across the screen)
- problems with connectivity (please keep in mind it could be your provider)
- charger that no longer charges the laptop
- issues with "pop-ups" implying a virus is present
- Access to District created sites (intranet, etc.)



Basically, the following instructions should only be used for mechanical problems making online learning impossible.

As before, questions about classroom expectations and instruction should be directed to the teacher.

Students...

- 1
 - Login the District intranet. This can be done from any device that has Internet access.
 - Click the "Tech Repair Log" from the left margin, then "Add a Repair Log".



- 2
 - Select any room number (does not matter which)
 - Type the specific technical problem you are having
 - Enter a contact phone number- very important for the Tech Department to arrange drop off/ pick up, etc.
 - Click 'Add Tech log' at the bottom

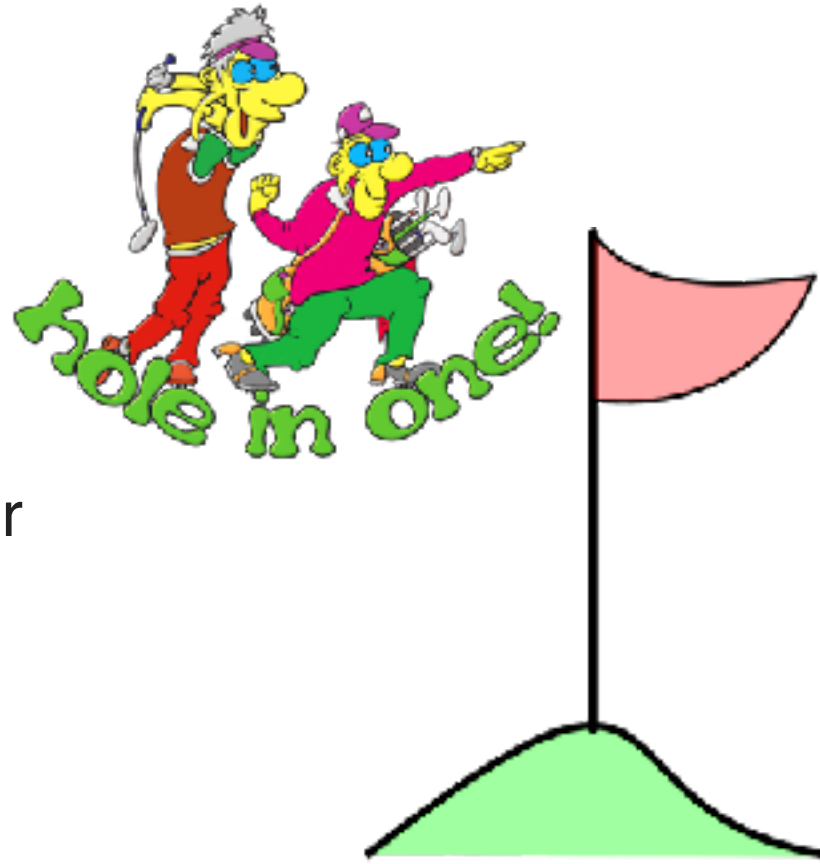
Someone from the District Tech Department should contact you. Please be patient as the process may take a few days.

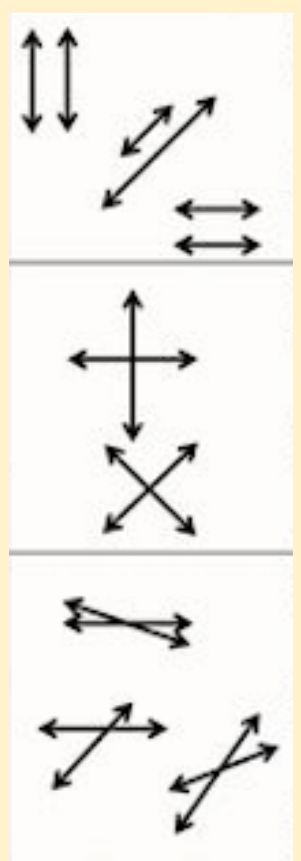

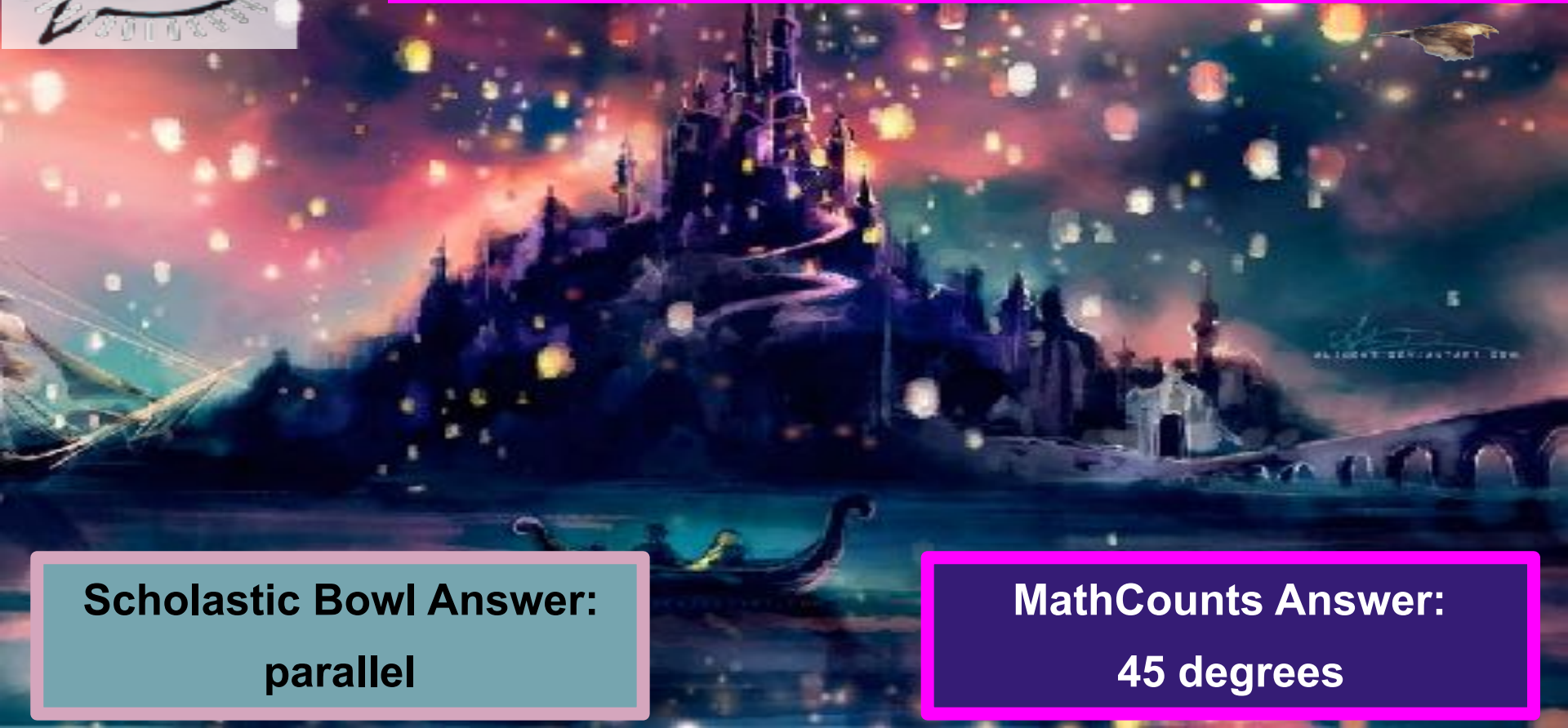
