

How to Log your student into their iPad

1. You will need their school email and password. If you didn't get it when you picked up the iPad, you can email the teacher.

2. Make sure that the iPad is logged into your internet. You will find this in systems folder. Look on the left, find WiFi, click that button, look on the right and choose your wifi. You will need to put in your home wifi password.

3. Open Chrome. If it isn't on the home screen, it will be in "self service". Once Chrome is open, find the small blue circle at the top right of the screen.

(Mine is a duck)

On the iPad this will be a small blue circle with the outline of a person or a blue circle with a letter in it. Click on the blue circle.

4. IF your child is already logged in you will see their name in the box. If your child is not logged in, you will see a place to type in their district email (lastname, first initial, maybe a number @students.sps186.org) and their password. This will be the first three letters of their birth month, with a capital letter at the

beginning, followed by a dot then their lunch pin. For example: Mar.123456

5. Once your child is logged in they will now be able to access Canvas and Pearson (Savvas) as well as Google classroom.
