

Remote Learning Student Expectations

Respect Yourself:

- Be prepared to learn
- Join class meetings on time in order to be marked present
 - Use an appropriate name to label yourself. (i.e. Your First and Last Name)
 - Inappropriate or incorrect names, pictures or GIFS for a Zoom should not be used
- Participate in activities
- Ask questions
- Do your best work
- Complete all assignments
- Communicate with your teachers
 - When in doubt, **email** your teacher about assignments, course meetings, etc.
- Follow the approved district dress code
- Make sure you have an appropriate space to work and meet virtually with teachers and other students during specified class period
 - **Appropriate Spaces:** Kitchen table, dining room table, desk in bedroom, living room, etc.
 - **Inappropriate Spaces:** In your bed under the covers, the bathroom, while driving a vehicle, at work, outside on a walk, etc.

Respect Others:

- Give teachers your full attention during Zoom and other online meetings when meeting during a specified class period
 - **Appropriate Behavior:** Being present for the entire Zoom/Online meeting, sitting up in a chair, keeping camera on face when possible and if on.
 - **Inappropriate Behaviors:** Video gaming, driving a car, playing on cell phone, sleeping, taking a walk, removing camera from face when camera is on, using complete face coverings when camera is on, inappropriate chat discussions
- Respect the ideas of others
- Use polite language and tone of voice
- Wait until it is your turn to speak
- Do your own work
- Do not attempt to distract other students or the teacher
 - Do not enter a Zoom meeting you are not supposed to be in
 - Remove face coverings when possible
- Stay off of your cell phone while classes are in session

- Use technology for school purposes only and avoid installing programs for personal use
