Project SCOPE will close over Winter Break to allow time for a thorough deep cleaning at each location. Following break, SCOPE will continue on a full-day schedule as long as District 186 continues to operate under full Remote Learning.

If the district adopts a Hybrid Learning schedule in January, our program will return to a before-and-after school program and will be open only to families who chose the Hybrid model for the second semester.

Current families **must re-enroll** their children for Project SCOPE under the Hybrid model. Please complete and return the paper registration form that will come home with students this week.

Please note this registration form is valid **only** if the district begins Hybrid Learning by Feb. 1st. If Hybrid Learning is delayed past that date, we will issue a new registration form.

“He helps make sure the students are following directions, submitting work and is always very willing to help when we ask,” she said.

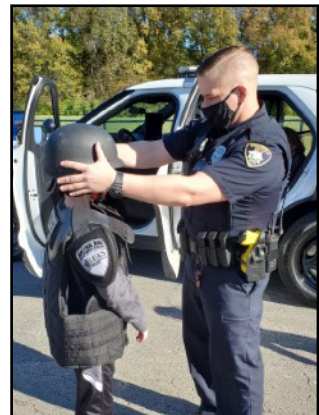
