Hours:

Project SCOPE opens at 7 a.m. and closes at 6 p.m. daily. We cannot accept your child before 7 a.m. For the safety of students, your child **MUST** be signed in and/or out daily. Please be prompt in picking up your child by 6 p.m. If you are late picking up your child, there is a \$10 late fee for every 15 minutes you are late per child. After the third late pick-up you are subject to dismissal from SCOPE.

COVID guidelines:

Students should wear a mask when they arrive at SCOPE (cloth masks should be washed daily). Parents should also wear a mask when signing their child in and out of SCOPE. Temperatures will be taken upon arrival and social distancing rules will be in place.

Payment:

Payment is due each week on the first day your child attends SCOPE (either Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday). Make checks payable to "Project SCOPE" and write your child's name on the memo line of the check.
