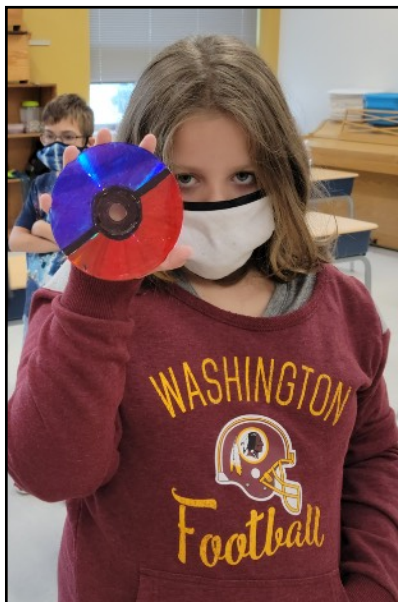


# Enos Summer SCOPE
