

# Enos Summer SCOPE

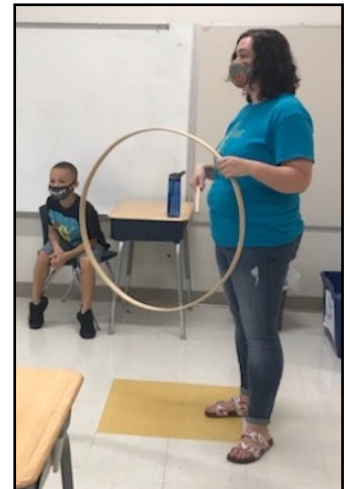
July 19 - July 23, 2021
