Reading

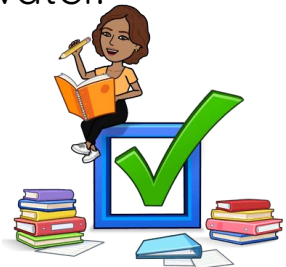
