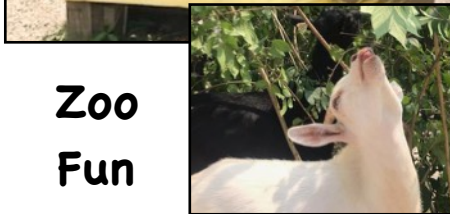


Hard to believe, but this week we are moving into August and the second-to-last week of Summer SCOPE.
