School Health Requirements

- All Pre-K, Kindergarten, 6th grade, 9th grade students and students new to Illinois schools must provide a current physical exam and immunization record. Students entering from another Illinois school must provide his/her most recent school physical and immunization record.
- All 6th grade students must show proof of having received all required vaccines including a Tdap vaccine, 2 doses of varicella and 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine at approved intervals. One dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine must be received on or after the 11th birthday.
- All 12th grade students must provide proof of having received a dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine on or after their 16th birthday.
- Kindergarten, 2nd, 6th and 9th grade students are asked to provide proof of a dental exam.
- Kindergarten students and students new to Illinois schools need a vision exam.

Beginning Monday, September 27, students who have not provided proof of physicals and immunizations will not be able to attend school until the requirements are met.
