

**All physical exams and immunization records must be received in the school office by October 1<sup>st</sup> to avoid exclusion from school.**

**Physical and Immunization Requirements by Grade Level**

- All Pre-K, Kindergarten, 6th grade, 9th grade students and students new to Illinois schools must provide a current physical exam and an up-to date immunization record. Students entering from another Illinois school must provide his/her most recent school physical and immunization record. Students from out of state must provide a current physical exam and up-to-date immunization record.
- All 6th grade students must show proof of having received a Tdap vaccine and three doses of Hepatitis B vaccine at approved intervals. One dose of the meningococcal conjugate vaccine must be received on or after the 11th birthday.
- All 12th grade students must provide proof of having received a dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine on or after their 16th birthday.
- Kindergarten, 2nd, 6th, and 9th grade students are asked to provide proof of a dental exam.
- Kindergarten students and students new to Illinois schools need a vision exam.
