

Lanphier High School Return to Learn Plan

2020-2021

We ask that students arrive no earlier than 7:50 a.m. This will help ensure social distancing of students and assist with building entry. Students will be required to wear a mask while in line waiting to enter the building and will speed up the health check and entry process. Students are expected to be off school grounds by 2:30 p.m.

Hybrid students are expected to be in attendance at school on only their assigned days. Please refer to the following Schedule:

A Days: Students assigned to school on **A Days** are to attend only on **Tuesdays & Thursdays**

B Days: Students assigned to school on **B Days** are to attend only on **Wednesdays & Fridays**

All students are expected to wear a mask (over mouth and nose) at all times Except when eating (mask must go back on immediately after eating).

Students are expected to follow social distancing procedures (at least 6ft) while on school grounds (inside and outside).

All students are responsible for bringing their Charged computer to school in their district provided computer bag with their charger.

Breakfast & Lunch: Students will be required to sit at a table (only 2 students per table). Students will not be permitted to stand or congregate.

Arrival/Morning Drop Off/Building Entry:

Two entrances have been designated for student entry. Only the Commons Ramp and North Entrance (11th & Converse) will be used for student entry.

Bus riders and walkers will use the Commons Ramp entrance to enter the building. Walkers may also use the North Entrance if that is closer. Car riders will be instructed to be dropped off along Converse to enter at the North Entrance. Student drivers will be encouraged to use the Converse and 11th Street parking lot and enter via the North Entrance. Students will receive their health check at their respective entrance.

Health and Temperature Check:

Each entrance will be assigned at least one administrator and one security member who will have a computer, thermometer scan and phone available at a desk set up. Students will have their temperatures taken and be asked questions using the symptoms screener. Additional personnel will monitor student movement from those entrances into the commons areas (large/small) and cafeteria.

Isolation Space:

Room 141 - formerly used as a classroom. Student's that do not pass their health check or are deemed symptomatic (which could occur during the course of the school day) will be referred to the nurse.

Breakfast Service:

Upon entering the building via the Commons Ramp students will receive a sack breakfast. Those students entering from the North Entrance will be handed a sack breakfast once they arrive in the cafeteria. Cafeteria Tables are arranged to allow for social distancing. Students will be required to sit during breakfast and lunch. Vending machines are off (soda and snack). There are 2 water bottle fill stations (large commons and main floor outside teacher lounge).

Limiting Visitors to the Building:

Lanphier High School will minimize visitors to the greatest extent possible. Our entrance desk supervisor is present 7:30 am-3:30 pm. The front desk supervisor handles drop off items at the main door and will relay that LHS prefers parents leave any items at the table, then security delivers item to appropriate office or student. If parents must enter the building, they are required to wear a face mask and successfully complete the required health screener. Security will escort parent to appropriate area.

Hallway Traffic:

Leaving from Breakfast: There will be staggered dismissal from the cafeteria in order to avoid a large crowd of students leaving all at once. We are looking at having 3 bells which will signal a group of students leaving the cafeteria (Seniors & Juniors, Sophomores, and Freshmen). Freshmen are the largest group and will need more support.

Lunch Dismissal: Smaller groups of students will attend each lunch shift. Students will be supervised during dismissal to monitor social distancing and mask wearing.

The district has indicated that hallways and stairways are wide enough to be used without designating directional patterns. Floor stickers will be utilized as reminders for students. Floor markings will be visible on each floor to promote social distancing.

Lockers: Students will have access to lockers which are assigned to promote social distancing. Students are required to put coats and bookbags in their lockers. Students will bring computers to school and will need to carry them in their assigned computer bag.

PE Locker Rooms will not be accessible: Physical Education students will not have to change for PE second semester.

Passing Periods:

Hallways will be supervised by teachers, security, support staff, and administrators. Students are expected to social distance and wear masks. Students will walk on the appropriate side of the hallway. Social distancing markings have been placed on the floor as a reminder.

Students will be staggered as they leave their respective classes in order to meet social distancing guidelines.

Elevator Usage:

Water Fountains:

Lanphier will allow plastic/metal (no glass) water bottles filled with water. A water bottle fill station is located in the commons and outside the faculty lounge. Regular water fountains have been turned off.

Lunch Service:

Dismissal for lunch: There will be 2 lunch periods as normal. Students may come down to the cafeteria when the lunch bell rings. Support staff, security, and administrators will monitor the hallways. Students will arrive in the cafeteria, get their lunch which has been prepackaged and will be seated. All vending machines have been turned off. Students will have access to a they usual milk choices and the water bottle filling station.

PE:

Due to safety protocols, students will not have access to locker rooms. Students will not have to dress for PE during second semester.

Restrooms:

Student restroom use is encouraged during the extended passing period time. Individual passes for emergencies is allowed, students will be directed to the closest restroom in order to maintain contact tracing information. The number of students permitted in the restroom is limited to 3 to allow for social distancing guidelines to be maintained.

Nursing and Isolation Spaces:

The school nurse will continue to support student health/well-being. They will provide appropriate first aid when needed and continue to administer physician approved medications. They will also be the point person when dealing with students having to be assigned to the isolation space.

Staff Training for Sanitation Protocols:

Hand Sanitizer, Sanitizer Spray, and rags are in each classroom. Teachers will sanitize desks, chairs, and other areas of their classroom at the end of each period. Students will wait outside the classroom if necessary (following social distancing guidelines) until the classroom has been sanitized.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Inventory and Requests: Masks will be provided at arrival entrance for any person who does not have a mask. Students will not be admitted to class without a properly worn mask (over mouth and nose).

Classroom Spaces:

Student desks have been arranged so that they are spaced to meet social distancing guidelines.

Dismissal Procedures (2:17 pm):

At dismissal, students will be permitted to access items from their locker and will be expected to leave the building via the closest exit. All staff will provide supervision during this time to monitor social distancing and the wearing of masks. Students are expected to be off school grounds by 2:30 p.m.
