

# CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT PLAN

### Respect Self:

- Students will be in the room and prepared for class when the bell rings. We will go over this the first day.
- If you are absent, it is your responsibility to see me, or the weekly lesson plans to determine what you need to make up.
- Sleeping when the class is on task is **STRONGLY** discouraged. If you are not feeling well, see me. If sleeping in class is a consistent problem, points will be deducted from your grade.
- Requests to go to the restroom, your locker or to get a drink will be granted only for true emergencies. Female students will be allowed to go to their locker prior to using the restroom.
- Cell phones need to be out of sight and turned off. **PLEASE FOLLOW THIS RULE.** If your phone is out, a referral will be written.
- Students arriving to class without the required materials will be sent back to their locker to retrieve them. You will need your book and something to write on and write with.
- Students **MUST** be in their seat until the bell rings to dismiss you. **DO NOT** gather by the door.
- If you have an unexcused absence on the day a test is given or an assignment is due, you will not be able to make up the test or the assignment until, the absence is excused by the attendance office. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

### Respect Others:

- Students will show respect to everyone in the classroom and their possessions (keep your hands to yourself).
- **DO NOT** talk when another student or teacher is talking.
- Students are not to work on homework from other classes unless you have permission from me to do so. This is a major pet peeve of mine, **SO PLEASE DON'T DO IT.**
- Please refrain from "Attention Seeking Behavior."
- When referring to the professional hockey team from St. Louis, you must refer to them as "Former Stanley Cup Champion St. Louis Blues." **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

### Respect Property:

- Please put all garbage in the trash cans, located by the window or my desk.
- Do not write on books, walls, desks, or other furniture.
- Students should keep book bags, headphones, and hats in their locker. Additionally, shoe bags are not permitted. Cell phones may not be used at any time and must be kept **OUT OF SIGHT.**

- Food and drink is allowed in class. Be warned, however, the first time I find a bottle, can, wrapper, or uneaten food in the seating area or anywhere else other than the garbage can, ALL SIX CLASSES will be put on probation. A second offense and all six classes will be put on double secret probation. A third offense and food and drink will be banned completely from room 324. PLEASE DO NOT ABUSE THIS PRIVILEGE AND RUIN IT FOR ALL SIX CLASSES.

### Positive Consequences:

- Verbal recognition (“Well done,” “Good work,” etc...).
- Phone call or email home.
- All class free time (if all behave, the last three to five minutes of class is generally “free time”).
- Be a Senator card will be issued.

### General Consequences:

- 1st offense-verbal warning
- 2<sup>nd</sup> offense-classroom detention
- 3<sup>rd</sup> offense-classroom detention and phone call home
- 4<sup>th</sup> offense-Referral to assistant principal
