Current Maintenance Plan	\$98 million facilities plan currently in place to address the most pressing physical and unmet functional needs in Springfield
Gaps	The missing components between existing and desired functional (educational) adequacy as defined by the educational standard. Construction work would involve extensive remodeling and possible additions throughout the building.
Comprehensive Reconstruction	Demolition and replacement of major building sections, and extensive remodeling of the remaining sections (e.g. historic sections)
Field House	Building to dedicated to a variety of diverse activities. For example an indoor track, basketball and volleyball courts, weight room, wrestling space, indoor batting/golf cages, larger gatherings, and
