## EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES MASTER PLAN

### ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS (All mobile unit classrooms will be removed)

- **Addams, Black Hawk, Butler, Dubois, Early Learning Center, Fairview, Feitshans, Harvard Park, Lindsay, McClernand, Sandburg, Southern View, Wilcox** will receive additions + classroom modernizations + life safety and infrastructure upgrades.
- **Graham, Iles, Lee** will receive classroom modernizations + life safety and infrastructure upgrades.
- **Laketown, Hazel Dell, Owen Marsh** will be replaced. Laketown and Hazel Dell will be combined and constructed on a new site. Owen Marsh will be replaced on the existing site.
- **Ball Charter, Enos, Matheny-Withrow, Ridgely** - Due to new construction, these facilities will receive minor life safety and infrastructure upgrades.

### MIDDLE SCHOOLS

- **Franklin, Grant, Jefferson, Washington** will receive gymnasium, cafeteria and classroom additions + classroom modernizations + life safety and infrastructure upgrades.
- **Lincoln Magnet School** will receive gymnasium + specials additions + classroom modernizations + infrastructure upgrades.
- New district-wide Middle School competition track will be constructed at the Washington Middle School site. District 186 owns the land and space.

### HIGH SCHOOLS

- **Lanphier High School** - The original historic building will be completely renovated, and the remaining portions of the building (including the Edison wing) will be torn down and replaced with modern spaces (classrooms, athletics, arts, sciences, career and tech prep etc.) designed to blend with the original building. An indoor athletic complex addition (3 full basketball courts) and an auditorium will be constructed. Existing parking and practice fields will be reconfigured, and Memorial Stadium will be renovated.
- **Springfield Southeast High School** will receive additions for classrooms, career and tech prep, special needs, and full competition field house. The existing auditorium, locker rooms and classrooms will be modernized, including life safety and infrastructure upgrades. Spartan Field will be renovated.
- **Springfield High School** - The original historic building will be completely renovated, and the remaining portions of the building will be torn down and replaced with modern spaces (classrooms, athletics, arts, sciences, career and tech prep etc.) designed to blend with the original building. An indoor athletic complex addition (3 full basketball courts) will be constructed. Additional property will be acquired to accommodate additional parking and playfields, allowing for practice fields for baseball and softball, and the consideration of the construction of a new SHS football stadium.

### WEST PROPERTY

- New District 186 baseball/softball/soccer fields (for MS/HS) will be constructed.

### ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION FACILITIES

- **Douglas (MS/HS)** will receive life safety + infrastructure upgrades (including security cameras) + additions for classrooms, cafeteria, workout/gym + classroom modernizations.
- **Wanless School** will be repurposed for the Springfield Learning Academy and will receive life safety + infrastructure upgrades + a gym addition + classroom modernizations. This building was decommissioned, but currently used by the SCOPE and Parents as Teachers program who will be relocated.
- **Lawrence Center** will receive life safety + infrastructure upgrades (including security cameras, toilet room renovations and fire alarm system replacement). Lawrence currently houses the Springfield Learning Academy and Diploma and Adult Education programs.

### ADMINISTRATIVE FACILITIES

- **Auxiliary Building** will receive infrastructure upgrades allowing for technology department expansion. Community based programs will relocate to the Curriculum and Administrative Center.
- **Curriculum and Administrative Center** - An existing facility will be purchased to consolidate the existing programs into one central location thus saving on overhead and create conditions for better departmental collaboration.
- **Operations and Maintenance/Warehouse office** will have minor renovations to add space as needed.
- **Instructional Resources Center** (the old Lindsay school) will be retired and programs re-located.
